THE BRIDGEWATER EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK WAS GIVEN TO COUNCILMAN ROBERT ROYCE TO GO THROUGH TO SEE WHAT WE COULD INCORPORATE IN WINFIELDS HANDBOOK.
