Councilwoman Susan Korosec:

She spoke with Beth Sadlon at Herkimer County Real Property Tax Service and due to system limitations on their end we need to revise the budget.

Susan gave a detailed explanation of what was changing and a discussion ensued.

Hired Mike Brown to plow snow part-time.

Deputy Highway Superintendent, Matt Peterson, picking up parts for the electric loader building. Looking to get garage door quote for loader building.

Councilman Robert Royce:

Income from sales of coffee cups and flags at centennial \$122 cash.

Councilwoman, Susan Korosec:

Starting January, Terri Atwell, town clerk, to print out and give a board copy of bank statement and cancel checks for each month.

Need to spend some time coming to a decision regarding Ambulance District vs Fire District.

Discussion ensued.

Supervisor William Miller suggested recruiting high school students from 17 to 18 years olds to obtain an EMT license and volunteer ambulance. The 17 years cannot drive an

ambulance but could go out and assist where needed. Board to discuss further at the next meeting.
